

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Between

Pawar Tech Services Pvt. Ltd & **Siddhant Institute of Computer Application**

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MOU) is made the **Pawar Tech Services Pvt. Ltd** at Pune, on the one part and the Siddhant Institute of Computer Application, Sudumbare, Pune.

Article 4. General Provisions

4.1 It is understood that the First party and the Second party subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity. Both Industry and the Institution shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement and neither party shall impose criteria for exchange of scholars or students, which violate principles of non- discrimination.

4.2 Both parties understand that all financial arrangements required for undertaking the proposed research/ training will have to be agreed upon separately.

4.4 Any research publications arising will be published in accordance with the provisions laid out in Item 3.2 of the Guidelines for the students to conduct research for their degree program as trainees or interns at Pawar Tech as notified vide the guidelines, if any, as may be issued from time to time.

4.5 No part of the work done in collaboration with Siddhant Institute of Computer Application will be published in print/ electronic media in any form without prior written consent of Siddhant Institute of Computer Application authority and vice versa.

4.6 All questions related to this MOU arising during its term will be settled by the parties by mutual agreement. Disagreements at the operating level shall be forwarded to respective higher officials for appropriate resolution, failing which an arbitrator of mutual acceptance may be identified for the settlement of dispute, if any.

Article 5. Intellectual Property Rights

5.1 Both the parties will be expected to ensure protection of the Intellectual Property Rights generated or likely to be generated during the student's or faculty or staff members research work and vice versa. Both the parties shall be joint applicants for any of the IP likely to be generated as collaborative research work. The first or second applicant among the two parties shall be decided based on Principal Investigator/s of the research work. Pawar Tech as the first applicant and the Second party shall be the joint applicants for IPRS and scientific staff involved shall be included as the inventor//author. For exploitation of the generated intellectual property, whose management and benefits sharing shall be mutually decided in each case.

Article 6. Entry into effect, modification, termination, and jurisdiction

6.1. This MOU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the parties and shall be valid for three years extendable up to five years. Both parties shall review the status of the MOU at the end of each three/five-year period to determine any modification, whenever necessary. The period of validity of this MOU may be extended by mutual consent up to five years. This MOU may be amended by mutual written agreement at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the Pune, a self-financed Computer Application run by CAYMET'S Siddhant Group of Institutes Society having its Head Office at Sudumbare Pune(hereinafter called Second party] who for the purpose of this MoU are hereinafter collectively referred to as the parties.



The parties, having discussed fields of common research interests and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into long-term collaboration for promotion of research and development in cutting edge areas of Computer Application and packaging in accordance with the provisions contained in the Guidelines issued by head offices of both the parties or as revised from time to time.

WHERE AS The "First Party" is a major technology, engineering, and manufacturing with global operations.

AND WHERE AS The "Second Party" is involved in research and education in the areas of Computer Application.

AND WHERE AS it has been considered expedient to agree in writing to participate jointly in the projects requiring expertise and logistics from both the parties.

Article 1. Scope

- 1.1 The Second party will recognize the First party as an Institute for conducting research and development in the field of cutting-edge areas of Engineering, Technology, Packaging and waste management like Automation, Functionality, IOT etc and vice versa. The First party will recognize Second party as Scientists/knowledge partners of the Siddhant Institute of Computer Application, as recommended by its Principal in accordance with the service rules and regulations for undertaking collaborative research projects.
- 1.2 Operational details of research effort and collaboration will be made in common research areas/ programs and/or projects restricted to specific mandated domain within the approved disciplines/divisions.
- 1.3 Research instrumentation facility and library facilities available with the First party and the Second party will be made available to the faculty, Scientists, students and research scholars. However, the costs of specific consumables / operational costs of the equipment etc will be borne by the respective organizations.

Article 2. Management



Partur District Jalna. Maharashtra. (Hereinafter referred to as "**Educational Institute (Beneficiary)**" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning hereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the SECOND PART.

The Company and Educational Institute are hereinafter jointly referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".

WHEREAS the Param Skills Training India Pvt Ltd is facilitating and providing employment and self-employment guidance for the youth to enhance their incomes. 3.9 To facilitate “Param Skills Training India Pvt Ltd” to work with all S.I.C.A. and utilize their premises and infrastructure to enrol the Jobseekers on the <https://paramjobsindia.com> portal and conduct operations for placement of Jobseekers like campus interview, small job fairs etc.

3.10 Each Party shall offer all the services **without any fees to the other Party** to facilitate the placement of Jobseekers.

4. Roles and responsibilities of “S.I.C.A.”

4.1 To identify and provide one SPOC (single point of contact) for the placement activity to provide all support, coordination, approvals, authorisations and permissions necessary for the implementation of the placement activity.

4.5 **Jobs** - The Company will work towards ensuring the placement of **minimum 2000 (Two Thousand)** Jobseekers in various job roles from formal and informal sectors during the specified period of this MoU and update the placement data on the <https://paramjobsindia.com> portal accordingly.

4.6 The “Param Skills Training India Pvt Ltd” shall work with all S.I.C.A. and utilize their premises and infrastructure to enrol the Jobseekers on the <https://paramjobsindia.com> portal and conduct operations for placement of Jobseekers like campus interview, small job fairs etc.

4.7 To work with the Param Skills Training India Pvt Ltd to develop a roadmap for scale-up of placement activity primarily or may help the Commissionerate to provide self-employment for the youth.

4.8 To report the progress of the achievement of the objective to the SPOC appointed by the Param Skills Training India Pvt Ltd in a format to be mutually decided by both Parties on a monthly basis.

Non-Financial MOU:

7. Intellectual Property Rights: Each Party shall retain exclusive interest in and ownership of its Intellectual Property developed before this MOU or developed outside the scope of this MOU. The protection of intellectual property rights shall be enforced in conformity with the laws, rules and regulations in force from time to time.

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9.3 Severance: Any provision of this MOU which is prohibited or unenforceable in any jurisdiction shall, as to such jurisdiction be ineffective to the extent of such prohibition or unenforceability without invalidating the remaining provisions hereof or affecting the validity or enforceability of such provision in any other jurisdiction. Accordingly, this MOU shall be construed as if such portion had not been inserted and the remaining provisions of this MOU shall remain in full force and effect.

9.4 Force Majeure: No Party shall be liable to the other if, and to the extent, that the performance or delay in performance of any of its obligations under this MOU is prevented, restricted, delayed

The Party claiming an event of force majeure shall promptly notify the other Party in writing and provide full particulars of the cause or event and the date of first occurrence thereof, as soon as possible after the event and also keep the other Party informed of any further developments. The Party so affected shall use its best efforts to remove the cause of non-performance and the Party shall resume performance as soon as such cause is removed.

9.5 Waiver: Except as otherwise provided in this MOU, failure on the part of either Party to exercise any right hereunder or to insist upon strict compliance by the other Party with any of the terms, covenants or conditions hereof shall not be deemed a waiver of such right, term, covenant or condition.

9.6 Amendments: No Party shall be bound by any modification or amendment of this MOU unless such modification or amendment is set forth in a written instrument signed by both the Parties.

9.7 No Assignment: Neither of the Party to this MOU will assign the MOU to any third party without prior written consent of other Party.

9.8 Further Acts and Assurances: Each Party agrees to execute and deliver all such further instruments and to do and perform all such further acts and things, as shall be necessary and required to carry out the provision of this MOU and to consummate the transactions contemplated herein.

9.9 The Parties hereby agree that they are not bound exclusively by this MOU and shall be at liberty to enter into any separate agreement or arrangement with any third party without reference to the other Party. However, each Party will disclose similar agreement or arrangement if entered or done with third party.

9.10 Entire MOU: This MOU constitutes the entire MOU between the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof as of the date hereof and supersedes all prior oral and written discussions and understandings between them with respect to the subject matter hereof.

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into on the date indicated below, by and between:

EXPERTEZE, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, located at Cambridge Massachusetts USA 02139, (hereinafter referred to as "EXPERTEZE"), and Siddhant Institute of Computer Application, Pune, Maharashtra, India 412109 (hereinafter referred to as "SICA"). Both organizations will hereinafter be referred to as "PARTIES".

1. PURPOSE:

1.1 The Parties recognize the benefits to be derived from collaboration, cooperation and mutual interaction for the development and promotion of joint activities to address issues of mutual interest, designed to foster and promote collaboration and undertake researchactivities.

1.2 This MoU sets forth the intentions of the Parties for increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction between themselves and does not create any legally binding commitments. Whenever the Parties agree to undertake specific joint Projects with legally binding operations, they will develop separate written agreement for such Projects setting out each Party's roles, responsibilities, funding, contribution, deliverables and budgets.

1.3 The purpose this MOU is to create a collaborative academic environment and framework between the SICA and EXPERTEZE for training students in the areas of bioinformatics, computational biology, genomics and systems biology and related areas (hereinafter referred to as "RESEARCH AREAS"), and provide opportunities for the students and participating staff to develop research skills and conduct independent projects of relevance to industrial research and development (hereinafter referred to as "EXPERTEZE PROJECTS"), as defined in the following section ("Statement of Mutual Interests and Benefits").

2. DEFINITIONS:

2.1 EXPERTEZE: The line of business established by HEALTHINNOVATORS, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, incorporated in Massachusetts USA, and located at Cambridge Massachusetts USA 02139;

2.2 SICA: The academic institution participating in collaboration with EXPERTEZE to develop, implement and conduct the program for the benefit of the students consistent with the academic goals of the institution;

2.3 RESEARCH AREAS: bioinformatics, computational biology, genomics and systems biology, artificial intelligence, machine learning, big data and related areas (as described in the website www.expereteze.org) as well as other academic disciplines as deemed appropriate by EXPERTEZE;

2.4 RESEARCH ORGANIZATIONS: public and private industrial research and development organizations engaged in research activities with EXPERTEZE. These organizations sponsor projects which are assigned to the students and student teams for performance at the SICA;

2.5 EXPERTEZE PROJECTS: independent projects of relevance to RESEARCH ORGANIZATIONS and assign to students at the SICA;

2.6 EXPERTEZE SCHOLARS, EXPERTEZE FELLOWS and EXPERTEZE RESEARCHERS: Students and Staff participating in the EXPERTEZE projects.

2.7 EXPERTEZE CIRCLES OF EXCELLENCE: Invitation-only programs to facilitate collaboration and networking between students and researchers in targeted areas of research and learning.

In consideration of the above premises, the parties agree as follows:

3. STATEMENT OF MUTUAL INTERESTS AND BENEFITS:

3.1 EXPERTEZE is dedicated, in collaboration with academic institutions around the world as well as public and private research institutions and laboratories, to creating, facilitating and promoting a scientific research oriented environment by which the students can train and learn complex scientific concepts in the RESEARCH AREAS; develop expertise in designing and conducting independent and group oriented projects in these and related disciplines; learn the basics of these areas of science and technology with focus on learning the underlying concepts and paradigms; design and execute laboratory studies that validate and extend published research papers and articles published in peer reviewed journals, and learn the skills necessary to read, understand, and validate the published results by independent laboratory effort; learn, understand and implement computer algorithms and become familiar with the tools, databases and other research artifacts pertaining to the study of the RESEARCH AREAS; learn the processes and procedures involved in collaborative research; learn the mechanisms and processes of research being conducted at world class organizations and industrial research laboratories (hereinafter referred to as "RESEARCH ORGANIZATIONS"), and learn to interface and communicate with peers, scientists and mentors in industry; and to develop mastery of these subjects and develop a passion for independent research in the RESEARCH AREAS, as well as related cutting-edge science and technology. SICA is an academic institution dedicating to fostering an effective learning environment and creating opportunities for diverse populations of young students in areas of limited resources and instilling in them a passion for learning and growth. Both EXPERTEZE and SICA together believe that by opening up the opportunities and guiding the students who are constrained by lack of conducive environment and resources, we can grow the next generation ready for the technological and social challenges faced by future generations, and level the playing field. Both organizations are committed to making effort and taking positive and proactive activities to create such a conducive environment and make a difference.

4. INTENT:

4.1 The intent of this MOU is to outline the activities and commitments by EXPERTEZE and SICA to promote the goals outlined in the previous section ("Purpose"), and to define the steps to help each other accomplish mutually beneficial objectives. The students participating in the EXPERTEZE projects will be called EXPERTEZE SCHOLARS.

5. EXPERTEZE shall:

1. Create a framework for establishing channels of research in the RESEARCH AREAS;
2. Provide resources and external relationships and intangible support to SICA to implement such channels of research at the college;
3. Provide resources, mentorship, feedback support from RESEARCH ORGANIZATIONS to the student teams engaged in EXPERTEZE PROJECTS as appropriate;
4. Make available academic materials and other mentoring support to facilitate the creation of favorable environment for conducting research and learning in the RESEARCH AREAS;

5. Establish channels of communication and interfaces to enable students to engage with external (public and private) industrial research organizations currently performing activities in the RESEARCH AREAS;
6. Design, suggest, propose, plan and oversee relevant topics of research in the RESEARCH AREAS of current interest to these RESEARCH ORGANIZATIONS;
7. Provide the point of contact for interfacing between the industrial research organizations and SICA;
8. Obtain and make available the funds to the SICA as appropriate for the conduct of EXPERTEZE PROJECTS, and otherwise manage the financial transactions relating to the conduct of the independent projects undertaken as part of this initiative.
9. It is the intent of EXPERTEZE to provide EXPERTEZE SCHOLARS appropriate financial support while working on EXPERTEZE PROJECTS, as well as appropriate Certificates of Merit, monetary rewards and other recognition of excellence to motivate them in this endeavor.

6. SICA shall:

1. Create an academic environment to facilitate formation and performance of EXPERTEZE PROJECTS by participating EXPERTEZE SCHOLARS at the campus;
2. Provide logistic and organizational support to EXPERTEZE to make this effort a reality and successful, including making available resources for ongoing consultation and collaboration with EXPERTEZE and RESEARCH ORGANIZATIONS;
3. Create structures and make available facilities for the conduct of EXPERTEZE PROJECTS by EXPERTEZE SCHOLARS at the campus facilities, including laboratory (e.g. "wet labs"), computer facilities, library facilities, as well as facilities for field work outside campus as appropriate.
4. Provide facilities for the establishment of an EXPERTEZE Office as a resource to students on campus for obtaining ongoing information about EXPERTEZE and conduct of EXPERTEZE related administrative activities within the campus;
5. Provide logistical, tangible and intangible resources (including faculty, post-doctoral and post graduate student support) for mentorship to the EXPERTEZE SCHOLARS engaged in EXPERTEZE PROJECTS;
6. Provide necessary support and guidance such as time for conducting research and balancing the needs of the students between conducting independent research and other academic responsibilities;
7. Collaborate with EXPERTEZE organization as needed in the smooth and focused conduct of the relationship to accomplish mutual goals, including periodic evaluation and assessment of the program effectiveness, financial matters and development of appropriate reward schemes;
8. Collaborate with EXPERTEZE and provide support for promoting and creating a positive impression and visibility to the public, as well as support the effort towards extension of the program to other organizations in India and around the world, and to facilitate interactions and engagement of EXPERTEZE SCHOLARS with others in other participating organizations;
9. Create appropriate training and initiation programs (including classes, demonstration sessions and coaching sessions) for students to become familiar and proficient with the processes and steps necessary to engage in EXPERTEZE related activities, as well as provide resources to help select the appropriate students to the teams based on the criteria defined by EXPERTEZE AND SICA in consultation with each other.

7. DURATION OF MOU AND TERMINATION:

7.1 The terms of this MOU will begin when both parties have signed the document and will continue indefinitely, until terminated by either party by giving a written statement to that effect to the other party. Upon termination, both parties will ensure that the termination of this agreement is properly disseminated to the third parties, without cause, and refrain from any activity that would imply such association as continuing thenceforth. Upon termination of the MOU, both parties will identify any areas of mutual concern (including but not limited to Intellectual Property etc.) and work to find a common and mutually beneficial resolution.

S. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY:

8.1 It is anticipated that during the course of the conduct of the MOU, researchers from the SICA will work closely with EXPERTEZE and other participating institutions on technologies of contemporary interest and value. The intent of EXPERTEZE is to disclose and publish the results of the work of the researchers in open literature such as arXiv and bioarXiv, which are industry standard forums for sharing the research output with the larger scientific community. Likewise, EXPERTEZE encourages the researchers to make available all supporting materials through public Github repositories. EXPERTEZE believes that, in addition to formally establishing ownership of their contributions, this mode of sharing established the credibility of the researchers in the community. The publications will include, in the title page of the published reports, the name(s) and the current affiliations of the researchers, as well as the attribution of support of the various organizations involved in the research activity. EXPERTEZE will also publish these articles in the EXPERTEZE website, again providing the credit and acknowledgement of support from the participating organizations for the research.

8.2 While the intent and focus of EXPERTEZE is to encourage open sharing of the discovery, there are certain situations when such open disclosure is not feasible. One such instance is when the researchers wish to hold off open sharing due to their wishing to conduct additional experiments or analysis prior to publication. EXPERTEZE will honor such requests and will support the researchers' decision in this regard. Another situation where such open disclosure will be deferred is when all parties (including all authors) believe that the invention has commercial value, and the invention is then transferred to a group in EXPERTEZE incubator for facilitating the startup activities based on the Intellectual Property, including filing of any patents or copyright protection. In all such cases, EXPERTEZE will be the sponsoring agency for the incubator team and will ensure that the Intellectual Property rights of all researchers and participating institutions are protected through the commercialization process. In these circumstances, the publication of the research results in open literature may be delayed by mutual concurrence, and efforts will be taken to publish the results in the open literature at the earliest feasible opportunity. In the case of any differences of opinion in any of the above steps, EXPERTEZE will mediate the process and seek to arrive at the best possible compromise.
